Timelines for examination of patent applications is **reduced to about 12 months** 



Examination for patent applications extended from 2 categories to **7 more categories now** 

New categories include SME, Female applicants, Govt Departments, institutions established by a Central, Provincial or State Act, which is owned or controlled by the Government, Government company, etc.



### Faster New Businesses





Setting up Central Registration Centre for name reservation and incorporation of companies & LLPs within 1-2 days

• 1,25,000 companies incorporated every year as compared to 50-60,000 companies earlier



"Reserve Unique Name" web service for name reservation for companies & LLPs, re-engineering the process of allotment of Director Identification Number



Zero MCA fee for company incorporation up to ₹15 lakh authorized capital, Condonation of Delay Scheme (CODS) 2017



Automatic system of approval for certain categories of mergers and acquisitions under "Green Channel"



# Cutting Through The Clutter of the Companies Act





Exemptions from various provisions of Companies Act to private companies, Govt Companies, Companies with charitable objects, Nidhis & IFSC (GIFT city) companies



Provisions relating to issue of shares with **Differential Voting Rights** (DVRs) modified



Enabling provisions with regard to Mediation & Conciliation under the Companies Act, 2013 enforced



Harmonizing norms with SEBI by reducing the time limits of public offers



Withdrawal of more than 14,000 prosecutions under the Companies Act, 2013



Rationalization of Related Party Transaction (RTP) provisions



First National CSR Awards distributed, Databank of Independent Directors launched

Decriminalization of technical & procedural violations under Companies Act



A total of 24 amendments to the Act (out of 42 carried out through Companies (Amendment) Act, 2019



Companies (Amendment) Bill, 2020 has been introduced in Lok Sabha to provide greater Ease of Living to law abiding Corporates



### **Ensuring Timely Relief to All** (1/4)

Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP)





₹1.70 Lakh Crore relief package for the poor to help them fight the battle against Coronavirus announced on 26th March 2020



Insurance cover of ₹50 Lakh per health worker fighting COVID-19



80 crore poor people to get 5 kg wheat or rice & 1 kg of preferred pulses for free every month for next 3 months



20 crore women Jan Dhan account holders to get ₹500 per month for next three months



### **Ensuring Timely Relief to All** (2/4)

Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP)





Free of cost gas cylinders to be provided to 8 crore poor families for next three months



Increase in MNREGA wage to ₹202 a day from ₹182 to benefit 13.62 crore families



An ex-gratia of ₹1,000 to 3 crore poor senior citizen, poor widows & poor disabled



### **Ensuring Timely Relief to All** (3/4)

Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP)





Front-loading of ₹2,000 paid to farmers in first week of April under PM Kisan Yojana to benefit 8.7 crore farmers



State Govts authorised to use Building & Construction Workers Welfare Fund to provide relief to Construction Workers



Govt to pay 24% of monthly wages into their PF accounts for wage-earners below ₹15,000 per month in businesses having less than 100 workers for next 3 months



For 3 crore aged widows & people in Divyang category, ₹1,000 to be given to tide over difficulties during next 3 months



### **Ensuring Timely Relief to All** (4/4)

Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package (PMGKP)





Collateral free lending limit increased from ₹10 to ₹20 lakhs for Women organised through 63 lakhs SHGs



Organised Sector - Employees' Provident Fund Regulations will be amended to include Pandemic as the reason to allow non-refundable advance of 75% of the amount or three months of the wages, whichever is lower



State Govt. authorised to utilise District Mineral Fund (DMF) for supplementing and augmenting facilities of medical testing, screening & other requirements



### PM Cares Fund to Fight COVID-19





**Providing relief to persons** affected from the outbreak of Coronavirus



Donation made to the PM CARES Fund to be eligible for 100% deduction under section 80G of the IT Act



Further, the limit on deduction of 10% of gross income not applicable for donation made to PM CARES Fund



Donation made up to **30.06.2020 to be eligible** for deduction from income of FY 2019-20



RBI permitted receipt of foreign inward remittances from non-residents through non-resident exchange houses in favour of **PM-CARES Fund**'



### Record Allocation for MSME Budget





₹7572.20 crore budget allocated for 2020-21 against ₹3007.42 crore in 2015-16, an increase of nearly 150%



99.40% of funds in 2018-19 and **95.67% in 2019-20 spent** 



Nearly four-fold increase in allocation for Infrastructure Development Programmes from ₹382.27 Cr. in 2015-16 to ₹1460 Cr. in 2020-21



Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP)





**PMEGP, is a credit linked subsidy scheme** to generate self employment in non-farm sector



Project cost upto ₹25 lakhs in manufacturing sector and **₹10 lakhs in service sector** 



Rs. 1950.82 Cr. Margin Money subsidy provided in 2019-20 to the unemployed youth for setting up of 66653 projects under PMEGP scheme.



Credit Guarantee
Trust Fund for Micro
and Small Enterprises





A unit can avail credit upto Rs. 2 crore under this scheme- up to 85% is guaranteed by the Government of India



Credit guarantee to the tune of Rs. 45852 crores given in 2019-20



### Interest Subvention Scheme for MSMES





2% interest subvention maximum upto ₹1 crore provided on outstanding balance



₹640.80 Cr. released & claims of over 9.96 lakh beneficiaries settled in the year 2019-20
