Expanding National Highway Network Across the Country





Projects for 3211 km length awarded & 5958 km length constructed till Nov 2019 in FY 2019-20



Rate of development of roads increased from about 11.7 km during 2013-14 to about 30 km now

Fastag rolled out on 16.12.2019 with total issued reaching about 1.68 crore



NHAI prepaid wallet launched with UPI recharge feature giving customers the choice of not linking FASTag to bank accounts



Road Safety on Priority





Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 amended 1st time after 30 yrs brings reform in areas of road safety, **protecting good samaritan**, **cashless treatment for accident victims**



Implementation of amended Motor Vehicle Act resulted in significant decrease in no. of road accidents



A State Support Programme to be launched to reduce overall fatalities of road accidents by 25% by 2024



Mandatory fixation of retro-reflective tape on all vehicles irrespective of date of manufacturing to enhance road safety



IT based road safety infrastructure to be erected on all the 4 lane & highways

Sharavathi backwaters bridge, approaches between Ambargodu & Kalasvali and 16 packages of Trans Rajasthan **Highways project awarded**



A 3-lane underpass at Parade Road junction on NH 8 in New Delhi operationalised



Dasna-Hapur section of Delhi-Meerut Expressway inaugurated on 30th September, 2019



2 laning of 6 road projects with a total distance of 174 kms in Arunachal Pradesh completed

Green National Highways Corridor Project to rehabilitate 781.38 km of NH in Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, U.P. & Andhra Pradesh



22 new Green Expressways Projects being constructed across the country



Development of industrial clusters around green expressways along with development of passenger amenities like cafeteria, resting places, toilets, fuel stations, etc.



Inauguration of 80 km long Dharchula-Lipulekh reduces pilgrimage to *Kailash MansarovarYatra by many days*



Paving the Roads of Development





Under SARDP-NE, 6418 km with an estimated investment of about ₹33,750 crore identified, out of which 3225 km completed

Easing Transport Services During Lockdown





Validity of all types permits, Driving License or vehicle related documents whose validity expires due to lock-down extended upto 30.6.2020



Provides food packets & water bottles near fee plazas & other places to truck drivers & stranded persons



A dashboard for information on availability of Dhabas & repair shops along with **NH; helpline 1033 to help drivers ferry essential item**



Daily monitoring traffic count across toll plazas through IT equipment by NHAI to ensure smooth flow of traffic to maintain movement of essentials services



About ₹11,000 crore released to various contractors/vendors clearing their pending bills during lockdown



Creating New Infrastructure for New India





1800 sq.mt. Airport Authority of India's land allotted for construction of new lounge at Tirupati Airport



3.7 acres of land allotted for Redevelopment of Pragati Maidan



Atal Bhujal Yojana launched with an outlay of ₹6000 crore for a period of 5 years (2020 - 25) to improve ground water management for 8350 GPs of 78 districts in 7 States



Capital Grant at 60% of estimated cost of ₹9265 crore for 1656 km North East Gas Grid project of IGGL approved



Contribution of Railways in the Fight Against COVID-19 (1/2)





Shramik Kalyan - Ensuring safe return of migrants to their home states, Shramik Special Trains started from Shramik Diwas (1st May)

- 3,840 Shramik Specials till 28th May. Total 52 lakh Shramiks moved
- Over 85 lakh meals and 1.25 crore water bottles
 supplied free



Special Passenger Trains - 30 Special trains started from 12th May, 2020 from New Delhi to 15 major cities



Make in India- Indian Railways produced 1.2 lakh Coveralls of PPEs, 1.4 lakh litres of sanitizer & 20 Lakh reusable Face covers



Contribution of Railways in the Fight Against COVID-19 (2/2)





COVID Care Centres

- Railways created over 3 lakh bed capacity in its coaches for use as COVID-19 care centres
- Earmarked 5,000 beds in 17 dedicated hospitals & 33 isolated hospital blocks for COVID care



Uninterrupted movement of freight operations

- Total 3,255 parcel trains run (from 22 Mar'20 till 22 May'20) out of which 3,160 time-tabled trains used for transporting essential items like medical supplies & equipment, food items, milk, dairy etc.
- Ensured 24x7 uninterrupted movement of freight & moved over 23.2 lakh wagons out of which 13.5 lakh wagon carried essential commodities like food grains, milk etc.

Best ever safety performance: Zero passenger fatalities during 2019-20, first time ever in the history of Railways



Best ever safety performance:

- Highest ever elimination of manned crossing levels -1,274 in 2019-20 vs 631 in 2018-19
- Highest ever Rail renewals 5,181 TKM vs 4,265 TKM in 2018-19

84 stations with mechanical signaling replaced with electrical signaling



Commandos for Railway Security

- First Railway Commando Battalion 'CORAS' launched to tackle the menace of terrorism and Naxalism
- 132 stations provided CCTV based surveillance system during 2019-20



Digitising Railways, Enhancing Passengers Experience





4,058 stations provided with high speed free Wi-Fi in FY 2019-20



e-Ticketing- Unreserved tickets for halt stations issued through Unreserved Ticketing System (UTS) terminals replacing earlier printed card tickets system



Artificial Intelligence based PNR confirmation predictor integrated with IRCTC website to predict the probability of waitlisted ticket getting confirmed



'RailMadad' serves as a Railways-only Portal for redressal of customers grievances.



Works Contract Management System (WCMS): An e-application IR-WCMS launched as a pilot project in 17 divisions of IR to handle works contracts on e-platform

For Coal company: Stocks and the coal requirement at power stations

Mangdechhu hydropower project (720 MW) in Bhutan commissioned in August 2019



₹1600 crore approved in July 2019 for pre-investment activities of NHPC's Dibang Multipurpose (2880 MW) project in Arunachal



NTPC's foray into hydropower sector through 100% share purchase of THDC and NEEPCO



Hydro-rich states of Jammu & Kashmir & Himachal Pradesh provided relaxations to reduce tariff of hydropower projects



Strengthening 'Neighbourhood First' Policy





Hon'ble PM of India and Nepal jointly inaugurated South Asia's first cross-border petroleum products pipeline on 10th September 2019



Hon'ble PM of India and Bangladesh jointly inaugurated the project to import Bulk LPG from Bangladesh on 5th October 2019



Hon'ble PM announced increase of subsidized LPG to Bhutan from present 700 MT to 1000 MT per month, in August 2019



Deepening Bilateral Relationships with Energy Partners





During FY 2019-20, India has elevated relations with major suppliers from level of buyer-seller to strategic partner



MoU signed between **Gol and Russia on use of natural gas for transportation**



Bilateral hydrocarbon trade with the USA increased from almost negligible in 2017 to become 11% of total two-way trade



UAE state-owned ADNOC supplied LPG and crude oil during production disruption due to attack on facilities of ARAMCO in September 2019



Significant Improvement in Trading Across Borders





'Trading across Border' parameter rank improved from 80 to 68 in World Bank Report on ease of Doing Business





Adopted measures like Direct Port Delivery (DPD), Direct Port Entry (DPE), Installation of scanners, etc



Introduced an upgraded Port Community System (PCS) to enable seamless data flow



Transforming Ports from Service Model to Landlord Model





Replaced The Major Port Trusts Act, 1963 with The Major Port Authorities (MPA) Bill, 2020



Provides operational autonomy for greater efficiency



Rs 65,544.54 crores allocated for Vadhavan port to be developed on 'Landlord model'



All business activities to be undertaken under Public Private Partnership (PPP) model



Modern Marine Security Features for Seafarers





India becomes the first country to issue **Biometric Seafarer Identity Document (BSID)**



New marine security features, including a biometric chip which is embedded in this security card based identity



Record of each BSID issued to be maintained in a national database that can be accessed internationally



Identification of the BSID holder to be more reliable and efficient, while protecting dignity and privacy



Provide ease of getting jobs to the growing number of Indian Seafarers



A New Dawn in the Lives of Lakhs of People



PM-Unauthorized Colonies in Delhi Awas Adhikar Yojana (PM-UDAY)



To give ownership rights to over 40 lakh residents in 1,731 unauthorised colonies in Delhi, National Capital Territory of Delhi (Recognition of Property Rights of Residents in Unauthorised Colonies) Act, 2019 enacted



Allow Registration Charge and Stamp Duty to be levied on nominal charge fixed by the Government instead of the prevailing circle rate as per the extant law



The property owners living in these unauthorised colonies can now enter into valid property transactions and raise funds from financial institutions



More than 2.5 lakh residents of unauthorized colonies have registered on PM-UDAY portal of Delhi Development Authority

Defence Initiatives Towards COVID-19 Management





Eleven (11) diagnostic labs under AFMS upgraded and accredited by the ICMR as COVID-19 diagnostic labs and four more in the pipeline



Over 9000 beds earmarked in 50 AFMS hospitals declared dedicated COVID-19 hospitals & mixed COVID-19 hospitals to cater for isolation and treatment



Quarantine facilities were created for civilians evacuated from overseas in Manesar, Jaisalmer, Jodhpur and Bhopal wherein 1725 evacuees from different countries China, Italy, Iran, Kuwait etc. successfully treated and released



Medical teams of AFMS were sent to Maldives and Kuwait to assist the respective Governments in their preparedness for COVID-19 pandemic
